TASTING NOTE



- Colour** Golden Sunset/Autumn Evenings
- Body** Medium weight, lively and vibrant with a splendid sweet fruity texture.
- Nose** The wonderfully alive aromas of crisp malt, oak vanilla and orange marmalade rush to impress and they certainly do. Waiting in line is soft cherry, raspberry, cranberry and rose petals. The red fruits coming from the spirits liason with the Rioja cask bring a Spanish warmth to the hones "Lets not get too excited remember who we are" Islander and it's a brilliant match. The melodious mix of aromas glide over the senses serenely with glorious malty notes willing the fruits to perform. An absolute olfactory dancer.
- Palate** Its racy and irresistible. Initially the sweet red fruity flavours tease the palate, soft and delectable creating the wow factor. Upping the tempo is the mellow syrup and sweet oak, closely followed by the malted barley which brings the heart and soul of Islay to this submariner. A dram to get lost in.
- Finish** Closure is prolonged with the Hebridean mantle burning brightly.
